Topic Details

The topic of discussion will be the "Deploy Once Platform" powered by PGP Universal, which can centrally manage policies for internal/external email encryption, virtual disk encryption, whole disk encryption, USB encryption, secure tape/archive encryption, instant messaging, and digital signatures. Jeff will be demonstrating the end user experience and the central administration interface on PGP Universal.
